

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

In order to retain the academic standards and to improve the quality of Education in the college an Internal Quality Assurance cell (IQAC) was established in April 2007 as a post Accreditation quality sustenance measure.

An urgent meeting of IQAC of NAAC was held on 18-09-2014 in which members of the planning committee of UGC were also invited. The agenda of the meeting was to discuss the overall development of the college during the session 2014-15. All the members present in the meeting unanimously approved the following development projects, initiated and finalized since 14-09-2012 when the present Principal Dr. Sneh Lata Badhwar took over the charge.

Under the Banner of IQAC renovation of the college building and many development works have been carried out. The details are as follows:

- The IQAC approved the ongoing renovation of the College building in which Chemistry practical stations were newly built, change of old Electrical wiring of the complete college, renovation of all the Toilets (Boys, Girls, Staff), renovation and the extension of the college canteen, the tile work of the floors.
- 2) The IQAC approved the construction of the new building which houses the Girls Dining/common room, Girls/ Physically Handicapped Toilet, Multipurpose /Conference room.
- 3) The IQAC approved the appointment of guest faculty lecturers against vacant posts so that the education of the key stakeholders does not suffer.
- 4) The IQAC approved of the concession in PTA to be given to siblings and student with good academic result who cannot afford to pay their fees.
- 5) The IQAC approved the distribution of funds obtained under Rashtriya Ucchatar Siksha Abhiyan (RUSA)
- 6) The IQAC approved the purchase of books to be bought under RUSA equity scheme in 2014-15 for reinforcing the existing libraries / book bank in the college.
- 7) The IQAC approved of setting up of new work station in the office of the college from infrastructure grant obtained under RUSA.



- 8) The IQAC approved of disbursement of all grants received under RUSA scheme as per norms laid down.
- 9) The IQAC approved of purchase of equipments for departments out of the funds sanctioned by RUSA for infrastructure.
- The IQAC approved of the publication of a multi disciplinary research journal 'Sutlej'.

 The Editorial Board of the journal has the complete approval of IQAC. Till date first edition of the journal has been released and the second has been sent for publishing.
- 11) The IQAC keeping in mind quality education approved the library committee's suggestion to get the college library fully automated to facilitate easy search of books in 2014-15. The automation has been completed successfully.
- 12) The IQAC along with the other members approved the themes: Celebration of Womanhood (Women Cell), Career Development by Increasing your retaining Power and Garnering Scientific temperament for the session 2014-15.

Session 2015-16

In its meeting in July 2015, IQAC prepared an academic calendar for the whole session and all the departments were directed to hold seminars, extension lectures and other activities throughout the session as per the guidelines suggested by IQAC. In the previous session IQAC took the project of automation of the college library renovation of the college hall, renovation and the extension of the college canteen, building of toilets for boys and girls and the tile work of the floors. In the current session, all these projects are complete. A new common room for the girl students has been prepared. IQAC still wants to do more for the quality education and building infrastructure.

- The IQAC approved the complete covering of open air theatre, completion of green rooms and laying of interlocking tiles so that all weather facilities can be provided, For this purpose Rs. 30 lakh have been deposited with the Executive Engineer, PWD (B&R), Ropar in 2015-16.
- 2) The IQAC approved the shifting of computer labs to the newly constructed building.
- 3) The IQAC approved the installation of incinerator, the completion of girls' bathroom as well as physically challenged students in new building.



- 4) The IQAC also approved the subscription to N-List Programme of Inflibnet, Ahemdabad for assessing the ICT Infrastructure for providing E-resources through the consortium from Higher Education Institute Society. By subscribing to this programme the faculty and students can have access to e-books and e-journals.
- The IQAC is thankful to the Higher Education Department for contributing Rs. Thirty four lakhs (Rs. 34,00,000/-) for repair and renovation of Infrastructure of the college. This amount has been deposited with the Construction Division of the PWD(B&R), Ropar.
- 6) The IQAC accepts the suggestion of the Higher Education Department for deposition of the semester fees directly in the bank from second half of the session 2015-16.
- 7) The IQAC approves the installation of ceiling fans and exhausts in the college Multipurpose Hall from the amount of Rs. 2,00,000/- sanctioned by Cabinet Minister S. Ranike.
- 8) The Year 2015-16 has been dedicated to save the Girl child keeping in mind the increasing skewed sex ratio in Punjab (Women Cell), Environment and Life of Baba Bahadur Ji (300th centenary year).
- 9) The IQAC has scrutinized the feedback forms filled by students of all outgoing students of the college in accordance with manual from NAAC. The summary of the feedback was prepared through the responses of students. The mechanism of using feedback for quality enhancement was appreciated by the members.
