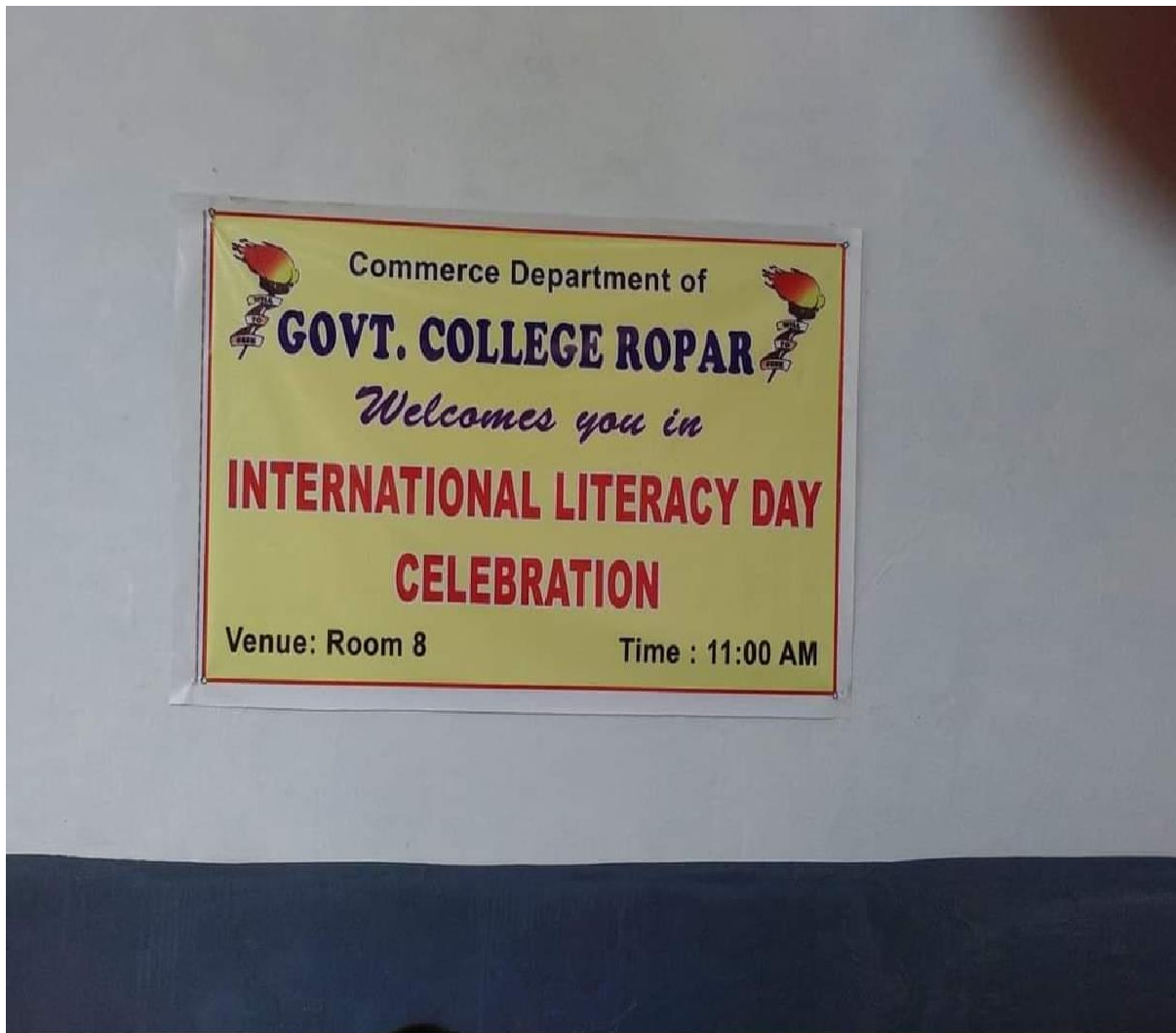

12. International Mother Language Day (22 February 2020)




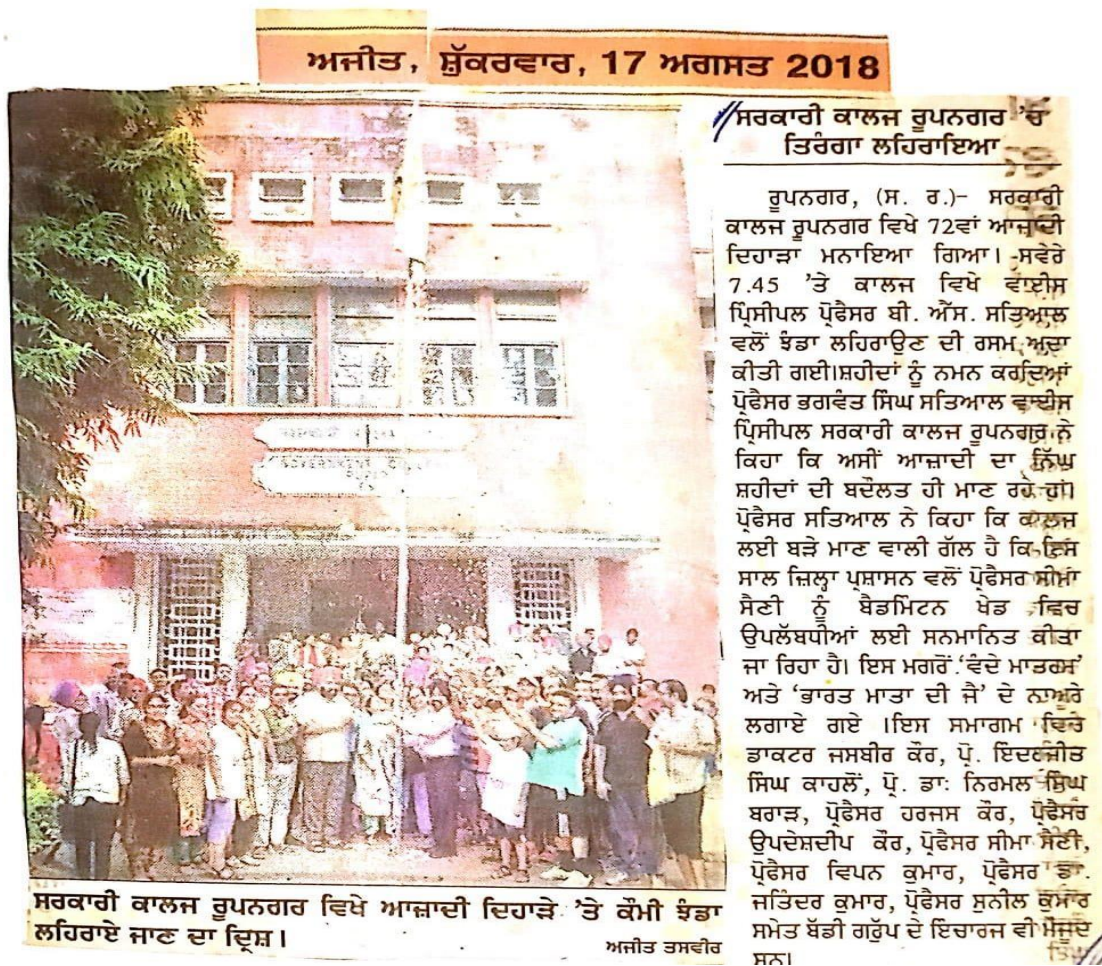
