1. Discussion on Institutional views on learner centric education:

Chairperson of IQAC Mr. Jatinder Singh proposed the undertaking of self financed courses such as M.Com and BBA. It was decided to send the proposal of these new courses to the university before 30 November 2022. Also, the members of IQAC discussed about the registration of the institute on abc.gov.in along with the registration of students for easy identification and verification. All of the degrees of the students shall be uploaded on the online portal. The members suggested the implementation of multiple entry and exit system in various courses. They also discussed on the adoption of credit framework for the students of HEIS.

2. Discussion on Institutional preparedness and views on digital learning.

Mr Jatinder Singh also suggested the formation of programs and crash courses for the online learning of various languages and also on the use of computers . Swayam and MOOC programs were discussed along with their relevance. Discussion was also done on ongoing Add On / Value Added/Short Term Courses being offered by various departments and their relevance to the students

3. Discussion on Industrial institute collaboration

Co - coordinator of IQAC Prof. Arvinder Kaur informed the members that MOUs with two institutes IIT Ropar and KMV Jalandhar are already signed. Also, collaborations will be done with the surrounding industries for easy employment of students. It was also informed by the Co - coordinator, that various alumni of the college have also been registered as startups to promote their work. Formation of a new research and development cell was proposed wherein various ideas on a research projects were given.

An idea regarding the survey of all the college students was discussed. It was also mentioned herein as to study about the growth of the students by the time they leave the college and also about the study of their social economic background.

4. Discussion on Awareness and preparedness on academic research and internationalization.

The collaboration with IIT Ropar and KMV Jalandhar as the learning partners was discussed. Also IISER Mohali collaboration was suggested. An elaborated discussion on the ranking of the institute by NIRE ARIA and ISO was discussed. It is worth mentioning here that proposals have already been sent for these rankings. It was also proposed that the faculty members will be given various opportunities for refresher and orientation courses, FDPS shall also be promoted.

5. Talk on Indian knowledge system.

College committee proposed the promotion of local languages by formulating crash course for the same purpose .The local languages discussed here were Punjabi and Hindi respectively. Also the Indian knowledge system's implementation was discussed.

6. Discussion on Institutional efforts to promote employability

Various ideas of self employment and entrepreneurship that could be introduced to the students were discussed by the panel. Also best practices followed by the institute were discussed .Other projects such as rain water harvesting, solar panel installation were discussed to be implemented etc. For this purpose eco club along with waste management society will be instrumental.

7. Discussion on Quality road map for institution

Activity plans for the month of November and December were discussed on the departmental level. Various activities were suggested. Also there were many interesting and innovative ideas for quality enhancement for the targeted group of final. The making of a recording studio was proposed by the members of IQAC. In the end Vice principal and Coordinator of IQAC Dr Harjas Kaur proposed a formal vote of thanks to all the members of IQAC.
