



SURVEY ON FEEDING, WEANING AND CHILD REARING PRACTICES IN YOUNG MOTHERS OF ROPAR DISTRICT

Survey Report

- In the session 2020-21, as a part of curriculum in practical paper of semester VI, a survey was conducted in Ropar district by Home Science department of Government College Ropar.
- This survey aimed to access the knowledge of young mothers about Feeding, weaning and child rearing practices.
- A self-prepared and close-ended questionnaire was used to collect the data. Total 75 young mothers from areas of Ropar district participated in this survey.
- Respondents were selected through probability sampling- simple random sampling technique. Participants gave the answer to 48 different questions and shared their experiences of post natal period.
- It was found that majority of **women (53%) had moderate knowledge** about child rearing practices Whereas **30% women had less knowledge** and only **17% of respondents were aware about child rearing practices.**
- In the study of feeding and weaning it was observed that **71% of respondents were not aware while 22 % had moderate knowledge** and only **7 % were those who had sufficient knowledge.**
